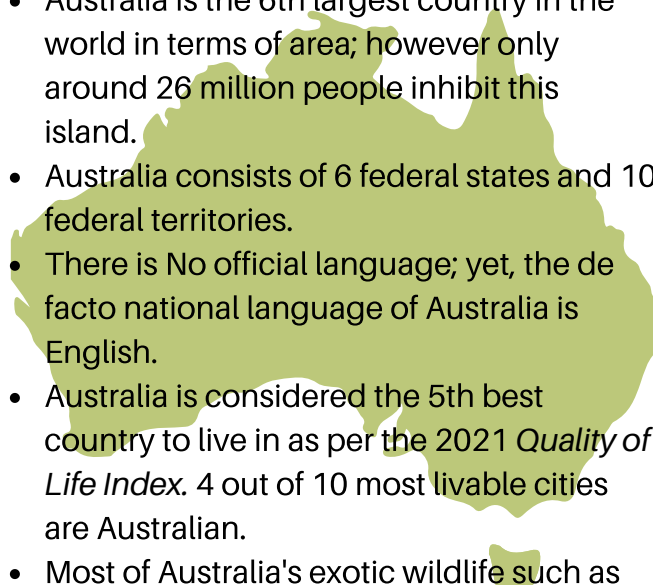

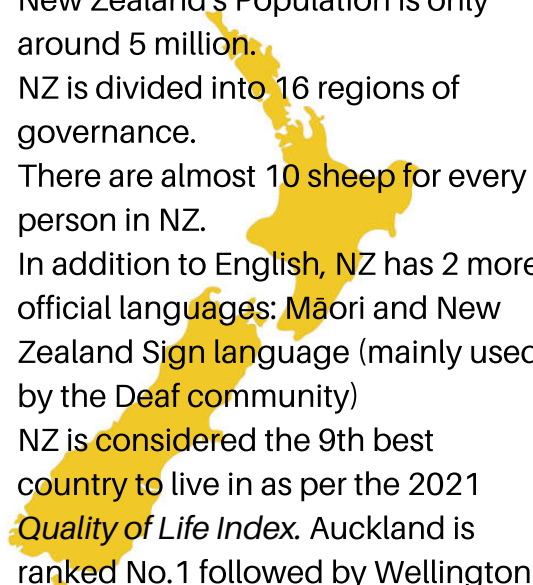

FACTS

- Australia is the 6th largest country in the world in terms of area; however only around 26 million people inhabit this island.
- Australia consists of 6 federal states and 10 federal territories.
- There is No official language; yet, the de facto national language of Australia is English.
- Australia is considered the 5th best country to live in as per the 2021 *Quality of Life Index*. 4 out of 10 most livable cities are Australian.
- Most of Australia's exotic wildlife such as koalas, quokkas, wombats and kangaroos cannot be found anywhere else in the world.



- New Zealand's Population is only around 5 million.
- NZ is divided into 16 regions of governance.
- There are almost 10 sheep for every person in NZ.
- In addition to English, NZ has 2 more official languages: Māori and New Zealand Sign language (mainly used by the Deaf community)
- NZ is considered the 9th best country to live in as per the 2021 *Quality of Life Index*. Auckland is ranked No.1 followed by Wellington at No.4 in terms of the most livable cities in the world.

- Australia offers high-quality education. Having seven universities in the top 100 shows the pedigree of their educational institutions.
- The universities have affordable tuition fees and living expenses, making it easy for the student and the family to plan out their finances.

- Australia also offers Permanent Residency (PR) opportunities for Indian students post their studies.
- You can work while studying
 - During School - 20 hours/week (part-time).
 - During Holidays - more than 20 hours/week (full-time).

Why choose New Zealand?

- New Zealand offers affordable tuition fees and living costs.
- International students who get enrolled in NZ with a PG Course are allowed to accompany their spouse on a work visa with a full-time work allowance.
- New Zealand is an immigration friendly country and offers prospects of Permanent Residency(PR) upon completion of study.
- You can work while studying
 - During School - 20 hours/week (part-time).
 - During Holidays - more than 20 hours/week (full-time).

STUDENT VISA

Australia: Student (Sub-class 500)

Australian Student Visa is granted for up to 5 years or in line with the duration of your study.

To be eligible for this visa, you must:

- Be enrolled in a study course in Australia and provide a COE (Confirmation of Enrollment).
- Hold Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC).
- Provide evidence of English Proficiency through IELTS (minimum 5.5) or other tests if applicable.
- Provide Financial proofs to support your tuition and living expenses.
- Meet the Health and Character Examination.

New Zealand: Fee-Paying Student Visa

New Zealand Student Visa is granted for up to 4 years or in line with the duration of your study.

To be eligible for this visa, you must provide:

- The Letter of Acceptance from a New Zealand education provider.
- The Offer of Place from an educational institution approved by the New Zealand Qualifications Authority.
- Evidence of the minimum IELTS score required for a New Zealand student visa is 5.5 band in each module.
- Financial proofs to support your tuition and living expenses.
- Meet the Health and Character Examination.
- A Valid Health Insurance

POST STUDY OPPORTUNITIES

- Within 6 months of completing your studies, you can apply for a Post-Study Work Visa or a Temporary Graduate Visa (subclass 485), which offers an extended stay and work opportunities for up to 18-24 months.
- Post this, you will have to submit an EOI (Expression of Interest) to be considered for the PR (Permanent Residency) VISA.
- On meeting the eligibility, you will be invited to apply for the PR that will be granted to you in about 5-10 months from the application.

- On completing your studies in New Zealand, you can apply for a Post-Study Work Visa, which is granted for 1-3 years depending on the level of your qualification and the city you completed it in.
- During this period, you can work for any employer and work in almost any job in New Zealand.
- After this period, if you have a New Zealand residence visa and have been living in New Zealand for 2 years or more, you may be eligible for a Permanent Resident Visa.
