

STUDENT DIRECT STREAM (SDS)

Under normal circumstances and for citizens of another country, the time to avail a student visa is anywhere between 90-120 days. However, for Indian students, there is a special provision called the Student Direct Stream or SDS.

Under SDS, the visa processing time is only 20 calendar days provided the students fulfill the following conditions:

- Admission in a full-time study program at a Designated Learning Institute(DLI).
- IELTS score of 6.5 bands overall with no less than 6.0 in each of the four modules.
- Purchases of a Guaranteed Investment Certificate (GIC) of \$10,200 CAD to cover living expenses for the first year of stay.
- Proof of payment of first-year tuition fees.
- The Medical Examination is to be done at least one week before the submission of the visa application.

POST STUDY OPPORTUNITIES

On completion of 1 year of study, you will be eligible for 1 year of Open Post-Study Work Permit. However, completing 2 years of studies provides you with 3 years of Open Post-Study Work Permit.

After completing 1 year of Full-Time Work (1560 hours) under your Open Post-Study Work Permit, you can apply for Permanent Residency (PR) under the Federal Skilled Worker (FSW), Canadian Experience Class (CEC), or Provincial Nominee Program (PNP).


